## Key vocabulary

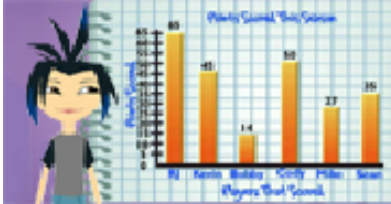
### **sector**

### **protractor**

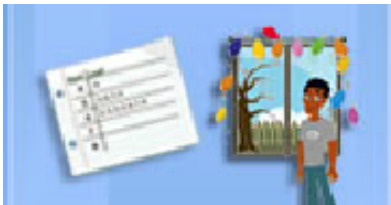
A semicircular instrument used for measuring and drawing angles. Protractors are marked off in degrees.

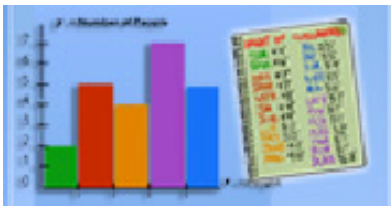
**Bar Graphs**

Got data that needs to be organized by place value? No sweat. A stem-and-leaf plot is just the thing.



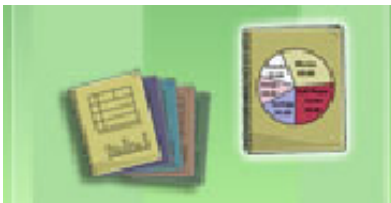
**Histograms**
