Food Webs



The food web shows all of the relationships between all of the plants and animals in a community. It also shows how different food chains interact with one another and overlap.



Key vocabulary

carnivores

An animal that eats meat.

consumers

A plant or animal that gets its energy (food) from other living things.

decomposers

An organism, like bacteria, that breaks down dead plant or animal matter and releases their nutrients back into the soil.

food chain

An ordered arrangement of animals and plants in which each feeds on the one below it in the chain.

food web

The complex network of food chains in an ecosystem.

herbivores

An animal that eats plants rather than other animals.

organism

A living plant or animal.

producers

A plant that gets its food from the sun's energy and that acts as a source of food (energy) for other organisms.

omnivore

An animal that eats both plants and meat.

scavenger

An organism that feeds on dead or decaying plants and animals.
